Job Title: Deconstruction Crew – Temporary Position

Position Summary:

The Deconstruction Crewmember is responsible for handling and processing used material donations through deconstruction techniques, donation pick-ups and ReUse Center donor drop-offs.

1. Deconstruct buildings and their components, maximizing diversion of construction and demolition waste for reuse and recycling.
2. Assist with donation pick-ups and deliveries of sold merchandise, ensuring excellent donor and customer experiences.
3. Provide support to the ReUse Center in the movement, processing and stocking of donated materials.
4. Uphold high standards of safety, adhering to all ReUse Center safety procedures.
5. Work collaboratively with volunteers, apprentices and trainees, ensuring they are performing meaningful tasks safely.

Required Qualifications:

- **Education and/or Experience:** Proven experience in a deconstruction or construction setting. Experience using power and hand tools safely and appropriately. Experience working safely on ladders and at an elevated height. Demonstrated experience working and solving problems independently without direct supervision. Must possess and maintain a valid NYS Driver License and clean driving record, and have experience driving standard transmission. No minimum education required. .
