

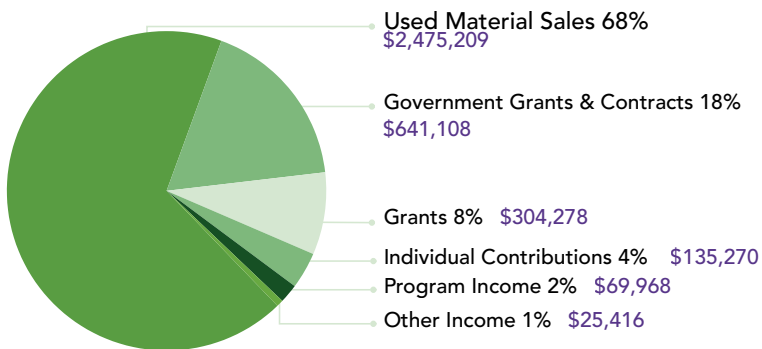

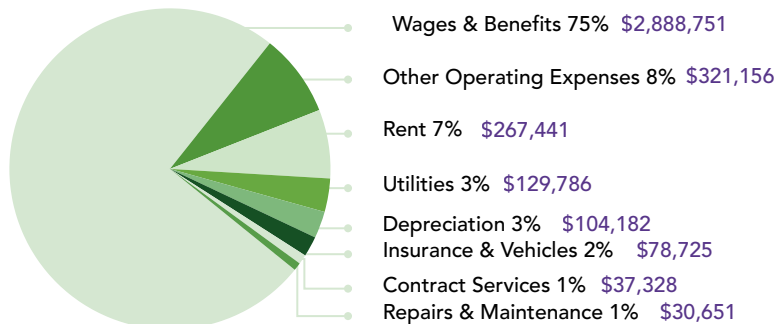
Highlights

In 2024, Finger Lakes ReUse advanced its mission across all program areas, with 84 employees and hundreds of volunteers supporting daily operations. The **ReUse Materials Access Program (ReMAP)** reached hundreds of households; the **ReUse Skills and Employment Training (ReSET)** program moved dozens of trainees toward living-wage work; and hundreds of thousands of items were sold and returned to local use. Sales and program fees covered approximately 70% of operating expenses, with community donors and grants funding the rest, sustaining an organization committed to protecting the environment by diverting materials from the waste stream into new, productive uses.
